Frequently Asked Questions

General Questions

Q: How do you select participants?

- A: Priority will be given to the following teachers:
 - All participants must teach in schools served by AEP Ohio and/or Columbia Gas of Ohio.
 - All participants must teach grades 5-12.
 - Preference will be given based on the number of teachers per school and/or district compared to the total number of applications received.
- Q: How will I know I have been accepted into the professional development workshop?
- A: You will be emailed a confirmation within two weeks of submitting your application.

Q: What is the cost for the program?

A: There is no cost. All professional development, classroom materials and student kits are FREE!

Teachers Who Participated Previously

Q: Am I eligible to participate again?

A: You are eligible to participate again if all required data and feedback for the previous year were submitted.

Q: Do I have to attend the full training again?

A: You are welcome to attend the all-day training but it is not necessary. There are several brief two-hour refresher workshops to select from. At the two-hour workshop you will be given a refresher set of classroom materials along with any new supplies and activities. Returning teachers will also have the opportunity to share their experiences with fellow returning teachers.

Q: Am I eligible to earn the One Semester Hour of graduate credit again?

A: Yes, but you must attend one of the all-day trainings to satisfy contact hour requirements.
