MAY 2014</b> Complete Final Summative Ratings – May 1, 2014 Provide each teacher with his or her written evaluation report – May 10, 2014 Biennial recalibration of all evaluators begins</p> <p><b>5. JUNE 2014</b> Complete Final Summative Ratings for Principals – June 1, 2014 eTPES closes for 2013-14 school year – June 15, 2014</p> <p><b>6. AUGUST 2014</b> eTPES opens for 2014-15 school year</p>	<p><b>1. AUGUST 2014:</b> Report card expands to include grades and reports on 16 measures</p> <p><b>2. WINTER 2014:</b> Financial data updated on report cards.</p> <p><b>3. AUGUST 2015:</b> Grades and reports on 17 measures; Grades for six categories and overall grade</p> <p>Results of nationally standardized assessment of college/career readiness added to report card.</p> <p><b>4. AUGUST 2016:</b> Grades and reports on 18 measures; Grades for six categories and overall grade</p>	<p><b>1. 2013-14</b> Third grade students who are not reading on grade level by the end of the year must be retained (unless they meet special circumstances). Retained students may take fourth grade classes in other subjects</p> <p>Third graders retained or are on a reading improvement plan must have a teacher with at least one year of teaching experience and other qualifications</p> <p><b>2. JULY 1, 2017</b> All educator candidates must pass a rigorous exam of reading instruction in order to receive a pre-K-3 or 4-9 license.</p>	<p><b>1. SPRING/SUMMER 2014</b> Teacher training offered for new kindergarten readiness assessment and related tools</p> <p><b>2. AUTUMN 2014</b> Schools begin using the new kindergarten readiness assessment</p> <p>Teacher training offered for new early learning assessment (preschool)</p> <p>Schools begin using the new early learning assessment</p> <p><b>3. NOV. 1, 2014</b> Teachers have until Nov. 1, 2014 to complete new assessment with kindergarten students</p>
