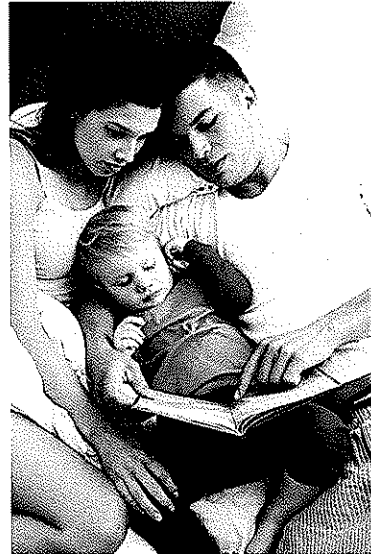

## Why enroll in Parents As Teachers Program?

*To help parents become their child's best teachers ever!*

### What can we offer?

#### Personal Visits:

Parents will receive personalized visits within the comfort of their home by a Parent Educator. The Parent Educator will share child development information and fun and playful activities where parents can interact with their child.



#### Group Meetings:

Group meetings provide a time to share with other parents and opportunities to practice activities with their child. Siblings are welcomed.



#### Prenatal visits:

Parent Educators can also provide prenatal home visits to help parents learn and prepare for their newborn child.

#### Benefits of Parents as

#### Teachers:

- PAT children were significantly more advanced in language, problem solving and social development at age 3
- Parents are more confident in their parenting skills and knowledge

#### Who is eligible?

- Pregnant women and families with children from newborn to age 3.\*
- Free of charge to Lorain County residents
- Qualifying families will receive free baby items

#### Developmental Screenings:

A Parent Educator will complete developmental screenings to track the child's development. This will give parents a better understanding of what to expect from their child and how to help them learn more.

#### Resource Network

A Parent Educator can help parents find out how to connect to the great resources in the community.

\* Additional eligibility requirement to be discussed at first home visit.

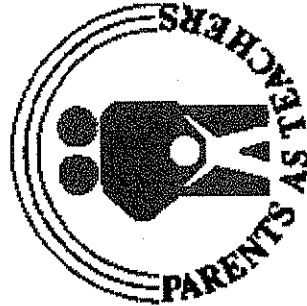
