- U Lack of a fixed, regular, & adequate nighttime residence.
- O Sharing the housing of other persons due to a loss of housing or economic hardship.
- O Living in a motel, hotel, trailer park or campground due to lack of alternative adequate housing.
- O Living in emergency or transitional shelters.
- O Abandoned in a hospital or other care-facility.
- O Not living with a parent or guardian while awaiting foster-care placement.
- O Primary nighttime residence that is a public place or *on the street*.
- O Primary nighttime residence that is a place not designed for or ordinarily used as, a sleeping accommodation for human beings.
- O Living in a car, park, public place, abandoned building, substandard housing, bus/train station.
- O Migratory living accommodations.
- O Not living in the physical custody of a parent or guardian as an *unaccompanied youth*.
- O Living as a *runaway* in a shelter or in a safe-house as a victim of domestic violence.
- O Living temporarily in a shelter as assigned by Juvenile Court.
- O Living temporally with a relative or friend or living as a *doubled-up* family.
- O Is being denied housing by a parent or their family causing him/her to be classified as a *throway*.
- O Living in a temporary home as a pregnant teen or unwed mother.
- O Living where there is no stability, adequadacy, or permanence of living arrangements.
