There are changes for Ohio schools that may affect you. Beginning this school year, your child will not be held back in 3rd grade if they did not pass the 3rd-grade reading test. All schools must now promote children to 4th grade. But, as parents and guardians, you always have the opportunity to work with the school to decide what would be best for your child's education. <u>Here</u> is a site with helpful questions you can ask your child's teacher.
