Eligibility

UYEP WORKS is free of charge to individuals who are:

- ✓ Are between the ages of 18 to 24 at the time of enrollment
- ✓ Are currently incarcerated in the adult criminal justice or juvenile justice systems in a State or Federal prison or local jail or state or local juvenile correctional facility AND will be released within 90 days of being enrolled in the program
- ✓ Are on probation or parole in the adult criminal justice system
- ✓ Have previously been incarcerated or on probation in the adult criminal justice system or the juvenile justice system **OR** are high school dropouts
- ✓ Residents of the Urban League's target community
- ✓ Interested and motivated to pursue basic-skills and career development, and post-secondary education and/or certification
