LEANOhio **Boot Camp** is for local leaders who work in Ohio cities, townships, counties, school districts, public universities, and other governmental agencies and organizations. The five-day session is entirely practical, with extensive hands-on instruction on Lean methods and tools.

The training is filled with public-sector examples and exercises. Included is an in-depth simulation involving a prototypical agency, so participants build their toolkits by way of a real-world situation. They will be able to use their new knowledge and skills immediately -- to make government simpler, faster, better, and less costly.
